



POLICY FOR PE KIT

ADOPTED DATE: October 2018

RATIONALE

The purpose of this PE Kit policy is to promote a consistent and fair approach for all children in the school when taking part in physical education, and to maximise their learning opportunities.

GUIDANCE

In accordance with our PE policy, every child in school should have the opportunity to participate in PE each week.

Therefore children in both KS1 and KS2 are expected to have the following kit in school at all times:

- White t-shirt
- Black / Navy shorts
- Plimsolls/Trainers

In outdoor PE lessons, when it is cold, warm clothing such as a tracksuit are to be worn. No hats, gloves or scarves.

Children should also ensure that:

- Long hair is tied back
 - All jewellery is removed
- Note: If stud earrings cannot be removed, then the child must cover them with tape
- They do not borrow kit from other children, including siblings (this is to avoid other pupils' kit being lost or children wearing kit which does not fit properly or is not clean).

If a child does not have their full PE kit in school, they will join the preceding year group, where they will be given some independent work (this may include reading, maths work or some other work as directed by the teacher).

Pupils who do not bring in their kit for one lesson will not lose Class Dojo points. However, in the event that this behaviour is repeated, sanctions may include Class Dojo points deducted, golden time lost or part of lunchtime lost. Consultation with DH where appropriate. Parents will be informed if PE kit is not being brought in regularly.
