## Religious Education

Religious Education helps us think about ourselves and others. Below are some activities you can do with your children. Please complete one a week.

### Key Stage 1

Religions teach us to help other people. Write a story about helping someone.

Make a model of a church.

Christians celebrate Easter in April. They believe Jesus died and came back to life offering people hope of new life. That is why we have symbols of new life at Easter. Draw some Easter symbols. (Cross, Egg, Bunny)

*Read the Easter story in a children's Bible or story book online.*

Design your own Easter Egg! What different chocolates would you include?

Think of one way you can help someone today and do it.

Easter is about hope. What is hope? Can you explain it?

### Key Stage 2

Jesus taught using stories with a meaning (parables). Write your own story that teaches us to help each other.

Make a collage or do a drawing showing the themes of Easter - hope and new life

*Read the Easter story in a Children's Bible or online story book.*

Write a poem about hope.

Design your own Easter Egg, what chocolates would you include?

Think of one way you could help someone today and do it.

Create a piece of music or a song about hope.
