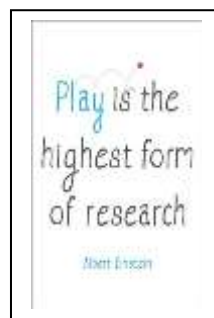
Saturday 8th December – Christmas Fayre 12-3pm please come along and support our School
