

Topic – Toys

History – We will be looking at different toys used in the past.

Geography – We will be looking at toys from other countries and comparing them to what we have in this country.

Art – We will be drawing/painting a picture of our favourite toy.

Maths

This year the Squirrels will be starting Maths Mastery which is made up of all the topics to be covered in the curriculum.

The topics being covered this half term will be:

- Numbers within 10
- Adding and subtracting within 10
- Shape and Pattern

As a team we will be acquiring a clear grasp of where they are and what we need to do to move them on to the next stage.

English

For English this half term we will be using the Scheme Talk 4 Writing to deliver Fiction and Non-Fiction texts. This scheme involves using images and actions to be able to retell a piece of text.

The texts being:

- Poetry: Show and Tell
- Fiction: The Three Little Pigs
- Non-Fiction: Recount – Grandparents visit.

We will also be concentrating on the use of capital letters, sentences, Proper and Common Nouns.

Reading

Reading this year for the Squirrels class is essential as it really does have a huge impact on their learning throughout the curriculum, specifically with their writing and phonics. Please do support your child to ensure that they read daily, and that you sign their planner to evidence this.

ClassDojo

We are using Class Dojo this year. Each child should have a log in so they can adapt their character and parent codes have also been sent home.
