

## Topic

For topic this half term, we will be looking at 'Animals including Humans':

- fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals
- Name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores
- Identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.

## English

For English this half term we will be using the Scheme Talk 4 Writing to deliver Fiction and Non-Fiction texts. This scheme involves using images and actions to be able to retell a piece of text.

The texts being:

- Poetry: Hairy Maclary
- Fiction: The Wanted: The Perfect Pet

We will also be concentrating on alphabetical order, 'a' or 'an', plurals and Pronouns.

## Reading

Reading this year for the Squirrels class is still essential as it really does have a huge impact on their learning throughout the curriculum, specifically with their writing and phonics. Please do support your child to ensure that they read daily, and that you sign their planner to evidence this.


## Maths
