Welly Wednesday

Starting Wednesday 8th September.

Children are to come to school wearing long sleeved tops, trousers, wellies and jumpers/coats. We will be going out in all weathers, so please ensure your child is dressed appropriately.

In **English**, we will be using a book a week, based on our topic; **Ourselves**, to help create opportunities for acting out and retelling stories. We will use a range of books to help us explore the world using a variety of resources.

In **Phonics**, we will be using the Jolly Phonic scheme to support the children with the phonic knowledge. We introduce a phoneme (sound) a day, using them to blend and segment when they are writing and reading.

In **Maths**, we will be exploring number up to 10 using the White Rose Maths scheme. We will be exploring the size of number and how it can be made up. We will be using a range of story books to help support the teaching of number.

Homework - This will not start for a couple of weeks. I will send out a Dojo when the work is being sent home.

Reading - They will soon be bringing home reading books as well. We encourage the children to read the book at least twice before we change the book. We will be collecting in the reading books on a Wednesday to be quarantined and then a new book will be sent out on Friday for your child to read.

Phonic homework - The children will have a book that will go home on Friday. It will contain a sheet of the phonemes we have covered and the words that they can practice segmenting and blending.

High Frequency Words - These will be sent home in a book, again collected in on a Wednesday and sent home on a Friday. We will be checking these 2-3 times a week. If your child is confident in reading these words we will add new words.

Numbots - This is an online computer program, designed to support children number recognition through subitising and recall. The children will start this homework in the Spring Term, unless we feel they are ready earlier.
